Instrumental Lessons for 2016/17

I am writing about instrumental provision for next year. As in previous years, we would like to offer a wide range of lessons. However, we can only run lessons if we have enough children wanting to learn a particular instrument and really need a minimum of 12 children for each instrument so that we can keep the cost down for parents.

In Year 3, we will continue to offer wider opportunities on steel pans, ukulele and also African drums, for which there will be no charge. Also, every child in school has a music lesson taught by myself on a weekly basis for the vast majority of the year, and the school choir is free and open to anyone with enthusiasm and a love of singing.

The cost for these lessons will be £55 per term, payable in advance. Please note that if the music teacher is absent a replacement is sent or the lesson is rearranged to a different day of the week. Unfortunately, if the child misses the lesson through absence we cannot refund the money. If you would like your child to learn an instrument next year please sign the slip below and return it to the school office by **Thursday 14th July**.
