Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Residential Trip 2017

As you are probably aware the current Year 6 children are going on an exciting residential trip in the summer term. However, next year we have decided to change this to an Autumn trip, so the current Year 5 children will now go on their residential in **September 2017**. We have made these changes so that the skills achieved from the activities on the trip, including team building exercises and resilience activities, can be applied during the children's last year of primary school.

We are pleased to tell you that we have booked for the children to go to Kingswood Colomendy activity centre in North Wales. We will travel by coach on **Friday 29th September 2017** and will return after a three-night stay on **Monday 2nd October 2017**.

The cost of the trip will be **£124** per child. To secure a place for your child on the trip please return the reply slip below, along with a **non-refundable £50 deposit**, to the school office by **Friday 10th February 2017**. Following payment of the deposit, the next two payments will be £50 due by 28th April, and then £24 due by 16th June. Payment cards will be sent out to those who pay a deposit and wish the spread to cost over more frequent, smaller payments. Please note that if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium then you are entitled to the trip being funded by school.
