Year 6 Visit to Crucial Crew

On **Wednesday 5th July** Year 6 will be going on a trip to Crucial Crew. This is an amazing opportunity for our Year 6 children to learn some valuable life skills. Crucial Crew is facilitated by the emergency services and is a series of role-play workshops. We will be having an early lunch on the day, and a coach will then pick us up from school at 12:15pm. We will be back in school by 3:00pm.

At these workshops the children are presented with various dangerous or challenging situations - such as a road accident or a gas leak - and they will be required to engage in role play exercises in how to deal with these situations. Crucial Crew is above all designed to be a fun way for children to learn life-saving safety messages. The course includes subjects such as health, police, public emergency, electricity, fire, seaside and bus travel safety.

School jumpers are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper, appropriate clothing to assist in immediate identification of any pupil attending a trip will be provided.

A contribution of **£8.50** to help cover the costs would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. Please return your slip and payment to the school office in an envelope with your child's name, class, amount enclosed and what the slip/payment is for by **Wednesday 21st June**. Alternatively, payment can be made via SIMS Agora. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school.
