Fine Motor Intervention Groups

This half term in Nursery we are going to be running some early morning fine motor intervention groups for small groups of children who we have identified would benefit from the extra support.

Fine motor control is the term used to describe smaller movements, usually of the hand and fingers. Fine motor control is best developed through activities which involve small-scale movements. Developing good fine motor skills is an essential part of children beginning to write.

We already do lots of fine motor activities in school but feel that your child would benefit from additional support. We are delighted to be able to offer these sessions.

The group session will run on a Thursday morning at 8.25am–8.40am. They will be based in your child's class and they will be run by Miss Glendon.

These 15 minute sessions will focus on developing your child's fine motor skills through a variety of short and fun activities. These will include dough disco, threading, using Lego and tracing.

These sessions will begin on Thursday 5th May at 8.25am.
