Getting Home After School

As a result of recent conversations with parents and carers, I am writing to clarify the school's policy on children leaving school unaccompanied at the end of the school day.

With written permission from a parent or carer, Year 5 and 6 children are allowed to make their way home unaccompanied by an adult; however, Year 5 and 6 children are not allowed to accompany their younger siblings home without an adult present.

Also, with written permission, older siblings and relatives, over the age of sixteen, will be permitted to collect their younger Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 siblings from school.

This policy applies to permanent daily arrangements for children. For ad hoc changes, please contact the school office. If you do not collect your child/children from school, please complete the slip below and return it to the school office.
