Dear Parent/Carers

Exciting Playground Developments

I am delighted to inform you that phase 1 of the playground renovation program has started today. A section of the middle part of the playground between the metal goal post and basketball structures will be temporarily out of use for the next three days as the contractors transform this area with a black wet pour rubber surface and markings. Wet pour is a continuous rubber surface which has excellent impact absorption and anti-slip properties. After the surface has been installed, court markings will be added to ensure that it is a multi-functional, safe and utilised space for all to use.



Phase 2 of the renovation (kindly paid for by funds raised by Friends of Oswald Road School) will be to install a 3G artificial sports pitch surface over the remaining two sections of the playground. The work on this area is anticipated to be completed during December when the playground will finally be transformed and ready for the new and exciting sporting opportunities that we hope to be bringing to Oswald Road Primary School during the New Year.



Naturally, the children are extremely excited at the prospect of this renovation work, but please can I ask for your patience and cooperation during this time as it is transformed, when parts of the playground might be unable to be accessed.
