Lifeshare's Christmas Appeal

Lifeshare is a small Manchester charity that works with the city's most vulnerable people, such as the homeless community, and young people at risk of exploitation. We provide all year support, including food and clothing parcels, advocacy and peer support.

For the last 25 years, our weekend breakfast and Christmas drop-in services have provided food and drink, clean clothing, bedding, toiletries and a warm, welcoming, safe environment to people in need. For seven days every Christmas, we bring together an army of 150 local volunteers to provide three hot meals a day, warm clothing, shelter and company at our Dantzic Street kitchen and dining rooms. Last year we served Christmas Dinner to 160 people as well as hot meals to about 100 each day during the Christmas period. Everything we provide at Christmas is donated – we receive no government funding.

Every contribution makes a world of difference to people with nowhere else to go this Christmas, and is deeply appreciated. We rely on support and contributions, which are gratefully received. The things we urgently need to sustain our service are:

Non Perishable Food & Drink

- Canned meat (spam, corned beef, hot dogs, meatballs), tinned fish, baked beans, tinned vegetables, tomatoes, soup, tinned spaghetti hoops/shapes, chickpeas, kidney beans, lentils.
- Tea, instant coffee, squash, pop, sugar, margarine, jam, marmalade.
- Pasta, rice, noodles, tinned fruit, rice pudding, cereals, biscuits, snack bars, crisps.

Clothing

- Trousers, shoes/boots/trainers, outdoor jackets, socks, jumpers, underwear, gloves, hats, scarves, dresses, skirts, holdalls/rucksacks,
- Sleeping bags.

Toiletries (not aerosol)

• Disposable razors, shaving cream, Soap, bubble bath, shampoo/shower gel (small bottles), toothpaste, toothbrushes, hand cream, deodorant, feminine hygiene products, perfume, aftershave.

Cleaning

Washing up liquid, gloves, toilet paper, bleach, washing powder, kitchen roll, paper towels, cloths.

Kitchenware

• Cutlery, mugs, foil, cling film, bags for life.
