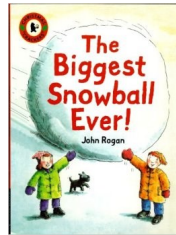

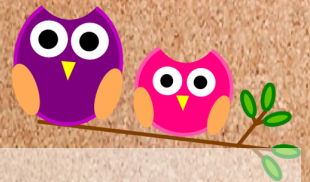


Our Book of The Week: The Biggest Snowball ever

Positional Language game: We've been talking about positional language and teaching the children about which words to use to describe where things are e.g. under, beside, in front, inside, behind.

Where is Teddy?

Can you play the game 'Where is Teddy'? Using a teddy, hide him in different places and encourage your child to tell you where he is hiding using the above positional language. You can also ask your child to place him in different places e.g. "Can you put teddy in the box?"
