Year 1 Visit to a Sikh Temple

We will be continuing our learning in RE about sacred places by visiting a local Sikh temple. We will then be comparing this with our visit to the church and the Hindu temple. We will be visiting the temple on Upper Chorlton Road. All of Year 1 will go on the morning of **Thursday 25th May**, and we will be back in time to have lunch in school as normal.
