English

Poem of the week: Ring a Ring o' Roses

We will be: Using our comprehension skills to work out the meaning of the famous song. We will then be writing our own verse using information we will be learning about the plague.

How to support your child: Teach them the nursery rhyme and talk to them about its meaning. Help them to come up with ideas for a second verse (maybe about the beak doctors).

Maths

We will be learning about: Measuring capacity and temperature. We will be making our own 'under the sea' potions by measuring liquids accurately and reading scales. We will then be measuring the temperature of liquids in different states and doing a temperature investigation.

Key vocabulary: millilitre (ml), litre (l), full, empty, half full, half empty, estimate, thermometer, degrees, centigrade, scale and minus numbers.

How to support your child: Let them look at the different types of scales in the house (eg. measuring jugs, weighing scales and thermometers) and explain that scales don't just go up in 1s.
