What is an Auction of Promises?

The Auction of Promises is an event we hold every other year as a school fundraiser. Parents and teachers have kindly put forward the donations listed in the catalogue, which are then auctioned to the highest bidder on the night just like a normal auction.

When is it?

The Auction of Promises is on Friday 16th June from 7:30pm. The auction

starts from 8pm. It's a great social night, so get a group of friends together and come along and bid, bid, bid!

There will be a bar serving drinks all evening, and you could grab yourself an amazing bargain too. Please note this will be an adult only event.

It will be a brilliant night, all the money raised goes directly towards school improvements, and you could even come away with something amazing...

All you need to do for now is sit back, have a look through the catalogue and decide what you're going to bid on.

If you can't make it on the night

If you can't make it along on the night, there are a variety of options to bid in advance or on the night:

Advance bidding form

Simply fill in a form in reception, with your details, which lots you wish to bid on, and your maximum bid. Then on the night, the auctioneer will effectively bid for you in increments up to your maximum amount. The deadline for advance bids is 4pm on Friday 16th June.

Online advance bidding

Similar to the above, but by email. Please email <u>oswaldPTAchair@gmail.com</u> with: Name, Contact number, Email, and then write Lot Number up to £...... for each lot you wish to bid on. The deadline for email bids will be noon on Friday 16th June.

Phone bidding

The easiest way to phone bid is to find a friend who is going on the night and ask if they can phone you just before the bidding starts for your lot, and they can bid live in the room on your behalf. If this isn't possible, then please fill out the lower half of the form in reception with your details and we will aim to call you as the lot begins. Please note, we cannot guarantee we will be able to get in touch on the night, but we will do our best!
