Oswald Road Miniature Garden Competition



For this year's Summer Fair, in conjunction with Unicorn grocery, Oswald Road PTA is holding our miniature garden competition. Use sticks, stones, moss, sand, growing plants, pebbles, craft materials, small toys, Lego people or whatever you can find to make a tiny garden in a container or tray. From fairy gardens to seaside scenes and dinosaur terrains, we are looking for the most creative designs, so let your imagination run wild!

- 1. Gardens should be designed in a container, tray or tin no larger than 40cm x 40 cm.
- 2. If you are using real plants, make sure you have a few holes for drainage in the base of your container.
- 3. Bring your finished garden to the office before or after school on Thursday 29th June, or between 3:30-4:30pm on Friday 30th June. Label your garden with your name and class.
- 4. Winners for each key stage will be announced at the school fair and prizes (kindly donated by Unicorn) will be awarded.
- 5. The gardens will be on display at the Summer Fair on Saturday 1st July. You can collect your garden at the end of the fair. Unfortunately, we do not have the space to keep them- any uncollected gardens will be disposed of.
