Science

Plants: In science we will be learning about plants and what they need to survive and grow in different environments. Can you name the different parts of a plant? Do you know what job each part of a plant has?

Geography

Abiku (Africa):In geography we will be learning about Africa. We will be using maps to locate the continent of Africa and different countries within it. We will be learning about some flags of Africa, climate, food and traditions. We will also be learning about the significance of the kente cloth within African culture.

ICT

In ICT we will be using Dazzle to create pictures of plants. We will be learning how to draw lines of different size and colour, fill spaces with colour and edit our work. We will also be using the internet to research different animals.

Music

In music we will be learning how to control and develop our singing voices as well as how to control instruments such as the Djembe.

Maths

This half term we will be rounding two-digit numbers to the nearest 10. We will also be exploring patterns in numbers and using these relationships to make and test predictions. We will be working towards becoming 'Masters of Maths' by using equipment and reasoning skills to explain and show how we solve calculations.

English

We are going to be reading stories such as 'Katie Morag', that will support our geography work on comparing and contrasting localities. We will develop our descriptive writing and work on the use of similes. We will continue to work on different punctuation and our joined handwriting.

We will look at articles in respect to Survival and Development, such as Article 27 – "All children have the right to a decent standard of living".

Art

Abiku (Africa): In art we will be learning about symbols in African art work and we will be using this to inspire us to create our own 'Secret Symbol'. We will also be designing and making our own kente cloth as well as a collage.

Religious Education

In RE we will be learning about different beliefs and the holy books linked to different religions. This links to Article 14 – "A right to practice your own religion".
