School Fund Account

Many schools choose to operate a school voluntary fund to enable the school to purchase extras that will enhance learning opportunities for the children. The voluntary funds are controlled by the Governing Body.

Many of you will know we have operated a School Fund in Early Years for some time and this has made a great difference and been very much appreciated.

Following on from discussions at a Parent Forum, we have decided to start a School Fund account for the whole school. We want to make it extremely clear that this is voluntary. There is absolutely no expectation that anyone contributes unless they want to/are in a position to.

The aim of the Oswald Road Primary School Fund is to raise funds from parents and sometimes from the children (who like to engage in enterprise activities). The purpose of the fund is to provide and enhance the learning opportunities of pupils across the school by providing and assisting in the provision of additional materials and equipment. It will support buying those 'extras'.
