House Captains

It's that time of year when we must recruit our new Oswald Road House Captains! Two boys and two girls (Captain and Vice Captain) from Year 6 will be selected to represent each of the school's four houses (Tawny, Snowy, Barn and Spotted).

Up until the SATs, the chosen House Captains will be given small responsibilities to lead their house, such as collecting house points, encouraging teamwork within their house, and leading house assemblies. Once the SATs are completed in May, when the House Captains will have more time to focus on their duties, they will be given additional responsibilities, such as supporting staff in the organisation of school events and fundraisers.

Applicants will then be given the weekend to prepare a presentation to be delivered **on Monday afternoon**. The presentations should be around 2 minutes long, and can take the form of anything, such as a poem, song or a poster.

A letter will be sent home on Friday giving details of when each applicant will have their presentation. The names of the chosen House Captains will then be revealed next week, and shall be presented with their House Captain badges in next Friday's highlight assembly.
