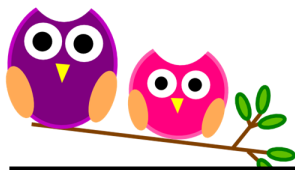

e.g. don't = a contracted (shortened) version of do not; and the **progressive form of verbs** e.g. I am **sitting**, he is **dancing**, we are **swimming**.

Maths

This week we will be looking at money.

We will recap on the value of different coins and will practise counting different amounts of money.

Things to think about:

Are silver coins always worth more than bronze coins? What is the quickest way to count the coins you have?
