Dear Parents/Carers,

Getting Home After School

I am writing to clarify the school's policy on children leaving school unaccompanied at the end of the school day. With written permission from a parent or carer, Year 5 and 6 children are allowed to make their own way home unaccompanied by an adult. However, Year 5 and 6 children are not allowed to accompany their younger siblings home without an adult present.

With written permission older siblings and relatives, if they are over the age of 16, will be permitted to collect their younger KS1 and KS2 siblings from school.

This policy applies to permanent daily arrangements for children. For ad hoc changes, please contact the school office. If you do not collect your child/children from school, please complete the slip below and return it to the school office.
