Maths: We are going to use related number facts.

Book of the week: The Fish Who Could Wish

This means that we can use addition to solve subtraction problems and vice versa. Eg. If I know that 13+7=20 then I also know that 20-13=7.

Key vocab: Add, subtract, calculation, equals.

How you can support at home: More practise on number bonds! Children need to know all the ways of making numbers to 10.

Fish Who Could Wish—can we identify the pattern? We will then be coming up with our own rhyming couplets. We will be using our Phase 5 phonics knowledge to write words that rhyme but are not spelt the same (eg. blue and chew)

How you can support at home: Play 'I Spy' with rhyming words. See if you can find a word that rhymes with things around the house.

## Phonics:

This Weeks sounds: ue, ew, u-e

New Terminology: Split digraph. When the two letters which make a sound (digraph) are separated by another letter (eg: gate, take, blame)

Tricky words: asked, could
