Announcements & Reminders

Maths: We are starting work on place value to 50. We will be looking at the tens and ones that make up 2 digit numbers (we don't say units anymore) and the different ways of representing these.

Key vocab: Tens, ones, whole, part, partition

How you can support at home: The children need to be able to count forwards and backwards to 50 from any number (it's especially important they can 'cross 10' eg: 42, 41, 40, 39, 38)

English: For the next two weeks we will be working on recounts. We will be looking at what makes a good recount including time connectives (first, then, after that, finally), conjunctions to join sentences (and, so, but, because) and identifying what, where, when and who.

How you can support at home: Lots of talk for writing. Ask the children to recount things they are doing. Make sure they recount events in order and encourage them to use some fantastic adjectives!

Phonics: This week's sounds are or, aw, au, augh

P5 sounds covered so fav: ay, a-e, ou, ie, ea, e-e. ie, i-e, y, ow, oe, o-e, ue, ew

How you can support at home: When reading (or in the environment) look out for the above sounds. If children are writing, encourage them to use the correct sound to make sure the word is spelt correctly.
