Lego Workshop:

The Lego workshop is on Monday. Please make sure you have returned your slip so that your child can take part.

Den building:

The children have done a brilliant job designing their dens this week. We still need donations of cardboard, bubble wrap, leaves, twigs and sticks, rocks, junk modelling materials and plastic sheeting. No toilet rolls please!





Maths: We are continuing our work on numbers to 50. We will be looking at one more/less than numbers within 50, comparing numbers using < (less than), > (greater than) and = (equals). We will also be ordering numbers to 50 and solving problems.

Key vocab: Tens, ones, more less, greater, equal

How you can support at home: The children need to be able to count forwards and backwards to 50 from any number (it's especially important they can 'cross 10' eg. 42, 41, 40, 39, 38).

English: On Friday we will be writing a recount about our experience at the Lego Workshop. We will be using everything we know about recounts to do a fantastic piece of writing. Us teachers are looking forward to reading them!

How you can support at home: Ask the children to tell you all about the Lego workshop. It's important they can tell you the main events in chronological order. Challenge them to come up with some adjectives to describe the Lego Workshop.

Phonics: What with the Lego workshop, den building and RE day we won't be doing a full week of phonics so we will be using the sessions to recap all the Phase 5 sounds we have learnt so far. We will be focusing on spelling.

Phase 5 sounds covered so fav: ay, a-e, ou, ie, ea, e -e, ie, i-e, y, ow, oe, o-e, ue, ew, aw, augh, au

How you can support at home: when reading (or in the environment) look out for the above sounds. If children are writing, encourage them to use the correct sound to make sure the word is spelt correctly.
