The Hoot

Maths: We are starting some simple division work. We will start by grouping objects into equal groups of 2,5 or 10 and then move on to sharing. We will be doing lots of practical examples of sharing amounts into groups of 2, 5 or 10.

Key vocab: equal, groups, share

How you can support at home: Lots of practical opportunities to share would be great! See if the children can share their toys between some teddy bears or some grapes between their family. Make sure the children are confident counting in 2s, 5s and 10s (forwards and backwards).

English: Our book is 'Too Much Talk', a West African folk tale. Now that the children are confident with the story we will be writing our own version featuring different characters and the objects that come to life and talk to them! Eg. a wizard whose wand talks to him or a builder whose hammer talks to him.

How you can support at home: Think

about some characters who could be in their story and the object that might talk to them (the character and object must be related to each other).

Phomics: We have now finished Phase 5 so we will be revising all the sounds we have learnt. This week we will be looking at sound families an all the different ways we know of making A, E, I, O, U. **P5 sounds covered so for:** ay, a-e, ou, ie, ea, e-e. ey, ie, i-e, y, ow, oe, o-e, ue, ew, aw, augh, au, ur, ir, ear, or, wh, ph, ou, oi, oy, ear, ere, air, are,

How you can support at home: Look out for some resources coming home to help your child practise for the phonics screener.
