Year 4 Science Club

Next half term we will be running an after school science club for Year 4, starting on Monday 18th June and running for five weeks. The sessions will last for one hour each, finishing at 4.30pm, and will cover the following topics;

Week	Topic
1	<u>What is Science?</u> A series of basic experiments and what we can learn from them.
2	<u>The Mighty Atom</u> Making models of the atom and understanding the basic structure.
3	<u>The Earth</u> Layers of the Earth, tectonic plates, volcano model.
4	<u>The Wonders of the Universe</u> Solar system model. What are stars? Why is the sun so small in the sky? Size of the universe.
5	<u>The Natural World</u> How did life arise on Earth? How did it spread and make so many varied forms?
