Geography

Following on from our study of Cottonopolis, we will look at the effect of the Industrial Revolution on Manchester's landscape. We'll visit Longford Park to complete orienteering and draw maps of our surroundings.

<u>RE</u> This term we will be comparing the similarities and differences between the major world religions. <u>English</u> This term we will be studying fiction and story writing – particularly how we can create an atmosphere, develop characters and engage the reader.

<u>Maths</u> In maths we will revisit everything we have been taught in Year 5 to prepare for our transition into Year 6!
