### How you can support over the summer:

- Ensure your child recognises all numbers from 0-100.
- Help them to count forwards and backwards from any number within 100.
- Help them to solve addition and subtraction problems within 20.

## How you can support over the summer:

- Keep practising handwriting, making sure letters start in the same place and that capital letters are taller than other letters.
- Make sure your child can spell all the Year 1 Common **Exception Words.**

Phonics: We will be playing lots of games this week as we keep consolidating all the sounds we have learnt in Year 1.

### How you can support over the summer:

- Keep reading! Lots of practice, reading a variety of different books. It is recommended that children read for 10 minutes a day.
- Focus on retelling. When children have finished a book, ask them to tell you what they have just read.
