We are all looking forward to a fantastic trip!

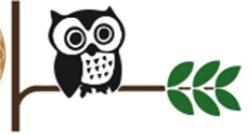

## Sample Kingswood Packing List

- 1 swimming towel and costume
- 1 bath towel
- Toiletries bag including toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush etc.
- Night clothes
- Socks and underwear
- 4 t-shirts, shirt or blouses (at least 1 with long sleeves)
- Sweatshirt
- 1 thick jumper
- 1 light sweater
- 3 pairs of trousers and/or jeans and/or tracksuit bottoms clothes for the evening activities
- A pair of shorts
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if possible)
- Sturdy shoes, such as walking boots
- 2 pairs of trainers, including one old pair
- A large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Drinking water bottle
- Sun cream
- A hat

*Please note, many of our activities require arms and legs to be covered.*

Children are likely to get muddy or dirty whilst on their activities so please bring old clothes! There is a gift shop on site so if children wish to bring pocket money with them we recommend they bring no more than £20.00. The children will be responsible for looking after their own money whilst at Kingswood.

What NOT to bring - these items are not covered by the centre's insurance:
