Reading Volunteers

We are looking for parents to put themselves forward as reading volunteers in school to help children improve their skills and develop an enthusiasm for reading. The role would require you to listen to children read on a one-to-one basis for a short amount of time every week (around 30 minutes per week). We'd like to emphasise that absolutely no teaching experience is required for the role- the purpose of the volunteers is for them to be there to listen to children read to give them practice of reading aloud to build their confidence and enjoyment of reading.

We will be holding a training session for all volunteers on **Wednesday 3rd October**. The session will consist of 2 essential parts:

Reading Strategies- 2.00pm – 2.45pm with Sarah Greenway

Safeguarding- 2.45pm – 3.30pm with Lisa Cameron

If you are interested in listening to children read in school on a weekly basis, please complete the reply slip below and return it to the school office by **Thursday 27th September** at the latest.

If you have been a reading volunteer in the past you will only need to attend the safeguarding training session, but you are more than welcome to attend the reading strategies session too.

All reading volunteers will need to hold a DBS (formerly known as CRB) certificate, which the school will fund and apply for on your behalf. If you have already worked as a volunteer at Oswald Road and your DBS is still in date then you will not need a new one.
