Reception behaviour system explained!

It became apparent after our 'Meet the teacher' event that lots of children are going home explaining our school reward system to their families and those messages don't always make complete sense unless you have seen them, so here are a few things explained that you may have heard your child mention at home!

Dojos- This is an online system where children have their own little alien picture next to their name on our big screen. If they do something great in school they get to press their alien and it gives them a point. Children can get a dojo for anything such as good tidying, being kind, listening on the carpet, producing a lovely piece of work, trying hard etc.

Stars Challenges- Every day there are 3 star challenges (usually one on each table in the classroom). These include one writing, one maths and one creative challenge. Children who complete these challenges can get a star on the star chart. They can then get a dojo for each star achieved. Please help by encouraging your children to complete their challenges each day.

Every Friday children attend an assembly in the big hall with our Nursery children. We give out certificates for our Dojo winner, our Mathlete (someone who has shone in maths that week) and our Rights Respecting Star of the Week (following our school rights and expectations).
