Phonics Workshop- Friday 5th October 9:15am (small hall)



Maths: This week we will be practising our counting (making sure that we can do 1-1 correspondence). We will be counting practical objects (like cubes) and then moving on to counting pictures on a sheet. We will also begin comparing numbers using comparative language (see below).

Useful vocabulary: Greater than >, less than <, equal =.

How you can support at home: Lots and lots of counting! Give children group of objects (up to 20) and ask them to count them. These could be real objects or pictures. When the children are counting make sure they give one number for each object.

English: We have been looking at the scene in Funnybones where the skeletons are in the park and we've decided that they need a picnic! We will be looking at captions, labels and lists and writing our own shopping list and on Friday we will be enjoying our very own picnic!

How you can support at home: If the children do any writing at home encourage them to remember four things...'think it, say it, write it, check it!' We are encouraging the children to be more independent and make sure that their sentences make sense.

Phonics: To ensure that all the children's needs are being met we are adding an additional phonics group that will be led by Miss Trundle (based in one of the Year 1 classrooms).

Miss Jones's & Miss Millward's groups: Revision of Phase 3 sounds:

Or, ar, ur, ow, oi, ear, are, air, er

Miss Dyson's group: Revision of reading and writing sh, ch, th, ng.

Miss Trundle's group: Revision of Phase 2 sounds and blending practise.

How you can support at home: Read with your child (aim for 10 minutes a day)
