Science Animals

We will be learning to identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

<u>History</u>

Pupils will be introduced to the concept of Remembrance Day and will learn why people in this country wear poppies in November. Through learning about Remembrance Day, pupils will understand that there are events beyond living memory that are significant nationally and globally, and that these are commemorated through anniversaries. Pupils will learn how to ask relevant questions about WWI and to deduce facts about the war based on their own investigations. Pupils will attempt to empathise with the people who lived through the war, and to use this knowledge to explain why it is important to remember significant past events, like WWI.

Computing

We will be looking at paint packages on the computer, trying to use a variety of paint tools to create images.

<u>Religious</u> Education

We have an RE day once a half term. We will be looking at Christmas and other religious celebrations.

<u>Music</u>

We will be experimenting with, creating, selecting and combining sounds using the interrelated dimensions of music.

<u>English</u>

We will be learning to write super sentences with capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will be reading our work back to make sure it makes sense.

Number: Addition and Subtraction We will be representing and using number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10.

We will be reading, writing and interpreting mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.
