Maths: This week we will continue to look at place value to 20. We will be looking at tens and ones in different numbers. We will also be exploring one more and less up to 20 and using language such as greater, less, more and fewer to compare numbers.

Useful vocabulary: more than, less than, equal to, greater than, less than, tens and ones.

How you can support at home:

When around the home you could ask children which is more or less when working in the environment such as when you're cooking with ingredients.

English: This week we will be writing about Freddie, our naughty elf! We will be thinking about all the mischief he got up to last week in class and ordering events in chronological order to write a recount.

How you can support at home:
