Year 1 Trip to the Lowry

As part of our history and art topics this half term, we have organised a visit to The Lowry. The children will be taking part in a workshop exploring Lowry's landscape pictures and getting a feel for the history behind the paintings. We will be leaving school promptly at 9.00am to catch the tram to Salford Quays, and will be returning to school during the afternoon. **1JD & 1SM** will be going on Friday 29th March and **1JJ** will be going on Monday 1st April.

A minimum contribution of **£6.00** to help cover the costs would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online for the trip via Parent Pay. If you would prefer to pay with cash, please come to the office to collect a barcode, which you'll be able to take to your local PayPoint to pay with cash. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school, however you will still need to give written consent for your child to go on the trip. You can do this either by emailing us or coming to the office to fill in a reply slip.

Children on school dinners will automatically be given a school packed lunch for the trip. If your child would like a specific sandwich filling, please email messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk. If we don't receive an order, we will choose for them based on their dietary requirements. If your child usually has a packed lunch and would like a school packed lunch for the trip, please email your sandwich order to messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk no later than **Friday 15th March**.

School jumpers are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper they will either be given a high-vis jacket to wear or a school jumper from the spares box so that they can be easily identified.
