## Nursery Trip to Smithills Farm

As part of our next topic all about growing, we are taking the children on a fantastic trip to Smithills Farm in Bolton. This is a fantastic opportunity for the children as there will be lots of exciting activities for them to do, including donkey rides, watching the cows being milked, feeding the animals and much more. The trip will take place on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May**. We will be travelling by coach, leaving promptly at 9.15am and will return to school for the normal time of 3.15pm.

A minimum contribution of **£17.50** to help cover the costs would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online for the trip via Parent Pay. If you would prefer to pay with cash, please come to the office to collect a barcode, which you'll be able to take to your local PayPoint to pay with cash. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school, however you will still need to give written consent for your child to go on the trip. You can do this either by emailing us or coming to the office to fill in a reply slip.

Children on school dinners will automatically be given a school packed lunch for the trip. If your child would like a specific sandwich filling, please email [messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk](mailto:messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk). If we don't receive an order, we will choose for them based on their dietary requirements. If your child usually has a packed lunch and would like a school packed lunch for the trip, please email your sandwich order to us no later than **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April**.

If you would like to assist on the day of the trip by being responsible for a group of children, please speak to your child's class teacher to let them know, or email [messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk](mailto:messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk). Once all final arrangements have been made and numbers counted, class teachers will confirm with you whether or not they will need you on the day.

School jumpers are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper they will either be given a high-vis jacket to wear or a school jumper from the spares box so that they can be easily identified.
