Useful vocabulary: More than, less than, and equal to.

How you can support at home:

Compare household objects e.g. pieces of Lego, pegs or toys. Which pile is greater/smaller? How can you prove it?

English: This week we will be continuing to work on our story of Handa's Surprise. We will also be looking at using capital letters for names and how to write a question.

How you can support at home:

Ask your child to retell you the story of Handa's Surprise using the actions we have come up with in class.

Can your child tell you if your sentence was a question or a statement? E.g. I like green = a statement, Do you like green? = a question.

Phonics: Mrs Craven's & Miss Millward's groups: Phase 5 sounds-ir, ear and or.

Miss Dyson's group: Phase 5 sounds u-e, aw, au, augh.

Miss Harman's group: Revision of Phase 2 sounds and blending practise.
