Reception Magical Circus Experience

As part of our 'Superheroes' topic next half term we have organised for a company called Magical Circus to come in and provide a fun and stimulating circus experience for the children in Reception, where we can all learn new superpowers. The session will begin with the children watching a short circus show with a range of skills including juggling, stilt walking, unicycling and tight wire walking. The children will then take part in a circus workshop, which will allow them to get involved in practicing different circus skills, which will of course all be age appropriate. The children will also learn about the history of the circus.

Magical Circus will be in school on **Tuesday 30th April** and **Wednesday 1st May** providing the children with a live circus show followed by a 2-hour workshop for each class. The second day will end with a live performance from our children demonstrating the new skills they have learnt.

A minimum contribution of **£12.00** to help cover the costs would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the session may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online for the trip via Parent Pay.
