Maths: This week we will be counting in 2s. The children will build on previous learning of counting in twos and go beyond 20 up to 50. They will apply previous learning of one more and one less to counting forwards and backwards in twos. For example, two more than and two less than. The 1-50 grid will be used to spot and discuss patterns that emerge when counting in 2s.

Useful vocabulary: 2 more, 2 less, forwards, backwards.

How you can support at home: Practise counting in 2s, forwards and backwards to and from 50.

English: This week we will be continuing to work on our story, Handa's Surprise. We will be learning about proper nouns and applying them to our sentences.

How you can support at home:

Ask your child to retell you the story of Handa's Surprise using the actions we have come up with in class.

Can your child tell you if a word is a proper noun or not? E.g. which are the proper nouns in theses words-bike, Jane, tree, London? (Proper nouns need a capital letter!)

Phonics: Mrs Craven's & Miss Millward's groups: Phase 5 sounds wh and ph.

Miss Dyson's group: Phase 5 sounds ir (shirt), ear (earth), or (work).

Miss Harman's group: Revision of Phase 2 sounds and blending practise.

Miss Trundle's group: Application of Phase 3 sounds and blending practise.
