Home Charter

These are the Articles of The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) that we think are important at home:

Article 5 : Your family has the responsibility to help you learn to exercise your rights, and to ensure that your rights are protected.

Adults will: Encourage children to learn about rights and protect their children's rights.

Children will: Share their learning about rights and respect adults and their decisions.

Article 3 : All adults should do what is best for you. When adults make decisions , they should think about how their decisions will affect children.

Adults will: Take the time to listen to children carefully.

Children will: Listen to the adults.

Article 12: You have the right to give your opinion, and for adults to listen and take it seriously.

Adults will: Consider and respect children's opinions.

Children will: Express their views calmly and respectfully. Be willing to speak up if something doesn't seem right and respect their parent/carer's decisions.

Article 27: You have the right to food, clothing, a safe place to live and to have your basic needs met. You should not be disadvantaged so that you can't do many of the things other children can do.

Adults will: Do their best to meet the needs of their children.

Children will: Be willing to speak up if something doesn't seem right and respect their parent/carer's decisions.
