healthy and safe.

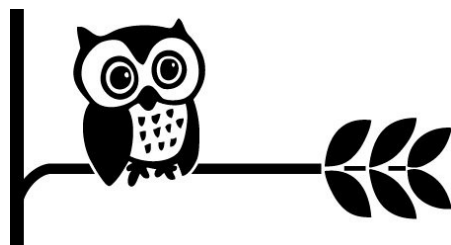
We are a rights respecting school.

# Home Charter

These are the Articles of The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) that we think are important at home:

**Article 5 :** Your family has the responsibility to help you learn to exercise your rights, and to ensure that your rights are protected.

**Adults will:** Encourage children to learn about rights and protect their children's rights.

**Children will:** Share their learning about rights and respect adults and their decisions.

**Article 3 :** All adults should do what is best for you. When adults make decisions , they should think about how their decisions will affect children.

**Adults will:** Take the time to listen to children carefully.

**Children will:** Listen to the adults.

**Article 12:** You have the right to give your opinion, and for adults to listen and take it seriously.

**Adults will:** Consider and respect children's opinions.

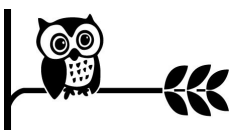
**Children will:** Express their views calmly and respectfully. Be willing to speak up if something doesn't seem right and respect their parent/carer's decisions.

**Article 27:** You have the right to food, clothing, a safe place to live and to have your basic needs met. You should not be disadvantaged so that you can't do many of the things other children can do.

**Adults will:** Do their best to meet the needs of their children.

**Children will:** Be willing to speak up if something doesn't seem right and respect their parent/carer's decisions.
