Year 4 Trip to Lancashire Cricket Ground

On **Wednesday 22nd May** Year 4 will be going to Lancashire Cricket Ground for their annual *Lancashire Cricket Foundation Schools' Open Day*. There will be a county cricket game between Lancashire and Worcestershire which the children will be able to watch. The children will also get the opportunity to take part in a range of fun activities in Lanky's Entertainment Zone.

A contribution of **£2.00** to help cover cost of the trip would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online for the trip via Parent Pay. If you would prefer to pay with cash, please come to the office to collect a barcode, which you'll be able to take to your local PayPoint to pay with cash. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school, however you will still need to give written consent for your child to go on the trip. You can do this either by emailing us or coming to the office to fill in a reply slip. Payments will need to be made no later than Monday 20th May.

School jumpers are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper they will either be given a jumper from the spares box or a high-vis jacket so that they can be easily identified.

Children on school dinners will automatically be given a school packed lunch for the trip. If your child would like a specific sandwich filling, please email messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk. If we don't receive an order, we will choose for them based on their dietary requirements. If your child usually has a packed lunch and would like a school packed lunch for the trip, please email your sandwich order to messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk no later than **Wednesday 8th May**.
