Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Visit to Crucial Crew

On Tuesday 9th July Year 6 will be going on a trip to Crucial Crew. This is an amazing opportunity for our Year 6 children to learn some valuable life skills. Crucial Crew is facilitated by the emergency services and is a series of role-play workshops. A coach will pick us up from school at 9.15am. We will be back in school by 11.45am in time to have lunch in school as normal.

At these workshops the children are presented with various dangerous or challenging situations - such as a road accident or a gas leak - and they will be required to engage in role play exercises in how to deal with these situations. Crucial Crew is above all designed to be a fun way for children to learn life-saving safety messages. The course includes subjects such as health, police, public emergency, electricity, fire, seaside and bus travel safety.

School jumpers or polo shirts are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper or polo shirt they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket so that they can be easily identified.

A contribution of **£8.50** to help cover the costs would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online for the trip via Parent Pay. If you would prefer to pay with cash, please come to the office to collect a barcode, which you'll be able to take to your local PayPoint to pay with cash. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school, however you will still need to give written consent for your child to go on the trip. You can do this either by emailing us or coming to the office to fill in a reply slip. Please can all contributions be made by **Tuesday 2nd July**. If you'd like to speak to us about any concerns you have about the cost of the trip, please contact the Finance Team.
