We will use stories, pictures and concrete manipulatives to explore making equal groups and write statements such as 'there are ____ groups of ____.' We will identify whether groups are equal or not. We will look at groups that look different but are the same. At this stage we do <u>not</u> explore multiplication formally.

Useful vocabulary: groups, lots of, rows, columns, arrays, multiples.

How you can support at home:

Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. It is important to do this **both** forwards and backwards.

English: This week we will be looking at dinosaur adventure stories.

How you can support at home: Start researching some facts about dinosaurs. Keep working on your spellings.
