



OSWALD ROAD PTA (FORS) PRESENTS THE ULTIMATE HIDE AND SEEK - LASER TAG & TREASURE HUNT WEEKEND – 11th-12th May 2019

LASER TAG

What is it? High-tech hide and seek. Various games will be played. Fun for all the family.

Who is it suitable for? Anyone age 6+ who wants some fun! (But it may be quite strenuous) Bring out that inner male or female ninja!

Is it safe? Yes. Completely. There are no actual lasers involved. The phaser units emit an invisible and harmless infrared beam; similar to a TV remote control. So, unlike paintball, there is no need for safety goggles and there are no projectiles involved. Laser tag is a non-contact sport. There is no age limit. We have hired the best equipment on the market from a company running since 2002.

Where will it be? In the school playground. We are asking for any spare pallets you may have to help build obstacles to hide behind – everything will be at ground level.

Is the equipment easy to use? Yes. Just switch it on and off you go.

What if I get thirsty or peckish? We will offer refreshments on a stall in the playground.

When are the session times? Saturday 11th May and Sunday 12th May from 11-6 for mixed adults and kids sessions. There will also be two adult-only sessions from 6-8pm on Saturday 11th May - but of course the rest of the family can watch. Each session will last an hour, with each game lasting around 55 minutes.

How much does it cost? The price is £10 per person and there is a maximum of 20 people per session. We will offer a discount if 10 places booked at the same time – so pay £90 for 10 people.

How do I book? Payment is via Parent Pay in the first instance. Unfortunately the system does not allow specific session booking so you will need to let us know your preferred session time, how many people have been paid for and their names and your contact details. In the event your session has been booked out, we will find an alternative. We will regularly provide updates re availability on social media and we can also answer e-mails quickly.

What if there's just me who fancies a game? Feel free to book either as a solo player or in a group. Either way, everyone is welcome.

How can I help? Firstly, by taking part! We are raising money for school. All profits will go towards the sensory garden in the playground as we continue with our plans to make the outdoor space more appealing to everyone and environmentally-friendly. Once the garden is funded, the school want to move on to other fundraising efforts so we need to press on now. We really need to fill as many spaces as possible to raise as much money as we can.

How else can I help? We need volunteers. We need at least one person on the stall and two/three people to manage the games for each session. It is very likely (subject of course to mutual availability) that volunteers for two or more hours will be offered a free session.

Anything else? Yes, we are looking for pallets to help set up our playground hide and seek.

What if I don't fancy running around and want a more peaceful weekend? Well, we have the perfect more peaceful alternative: the Oswald Road School Treasure Hunt

TREASURE HUNT

What is it? The treasure hunt will take you around the centre of Chorlton to find answers to questions as well as spot some clues.

Who is it suitable for? Anyone and everyone. There is no age limit. Enter as a group of friends or a family.

How much does it cost? £5 per entry, so £5 per group payable via Parent Pay in the first instance.

How do I get a copy of the quiz? They will be available on Friday 10th May 2019 at the school Office and then over the weekend at the playground stall.

Is there a deadline? Yes. We don't need the copies back the same day if not convenient, but you have until the end of the day on Monday 13th May to hand it in at the Office. We will trust you with your timings!

Is there a prize? There will be a small prize for the entry with the fastest time. All entrants will receive a certificate for their efforts.

What if I forget to book either Laser Tag or the Treasure Hunt? There will be an opportunity to pay in cash on the day from the stall in the playground. Laser Tag sessions will be subject to availability so groups may need to be split up – so best to pre-book if there are a group of you.
