Maths: We are carrying on with our work on time. We will be solving time-based problems and also sequencing the events of the day. We will also do some simple measuring in minutes and seconds. We will be also learning to recognise the coins and notes as a basic skill every day.

The Hoot

Useful vocabulary: Clock, hands, face, hour, half past. Half hour, time, earlier, later, o'clock, pounds, pence (different coin values)

How you can support at home: Help the children to name and sequence the days of the week and months of the year in the correct order.

English: Our new book is 'Aliens Love Underpants'. We will be doing some character descriptions and even designing our own aliens. We are making sure all the children's work has the year 1 essentials: finger spaces, full stops, capital letters, nice hand-writing, words spelt correctly and sentences that make sense!

How you can support at home: Any support with spelling would be appreciated! Please do the weekly spellings each week and point out words in books or the environment that they may find difficult.

Phonics: Now that we have completed the phonics screener we will be focussing on spelling. We will be using the sounds we have learnt this year to correctly spell common words (eg. make instead of maik). We will also be learning to use suffixes ing, ed, er and est.

How you can support at home: Read with your child at home for 10 minutes each night. Don't forget to ask them comprehension questions and help them retell the story.
