Year 2 Trip to Staircase House

As part of our upcoming topic 'Was anyone to blame for the 17th Century Madness?' we will be visiting Staircase House in Stockport. It is a really enjoyable trip and a fantastic way to bring the topic to life. The dates for the trip are as follows:

We will be leaving school at 9:00am and travelling by coach to Stockport. We will be back in time for the end of the day. School jumpers or polo shirts are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper, they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket to wear so that they can be easily identified.

A contribution of **£17.00** to help cover the costs would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient contributions the trip may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online for the trip via Parent Pay. If you would prefer to pay with cash, please come to the office to collect a barcode, which you'll be able to take to your local PayPoint to pay with cash. Please ensure that all payments are made by **Wednesday 26th June**. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school, however you will still need to give written consent for your child to go on the trip. You can do this either by emailing messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk or coming to the office to fill in a reply slip.

Children on school dinners will automatically be given a school packed lunch for the trip. If your child would like a specific sandwich filling, please email messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk. If we don't receive an order, we will choose for them based on their dietary requirements. If your child usually has a packed lunch and would like a school packed lunch for the trip, please email your sandwich order to messages@oswaldroad.manchester.sch.uk no later than Friday 21st June. Please make sure your child's lunch is in a rucksack or other bag, which they can carry around with them for the whole day.
