## Announcements & Event Reminders

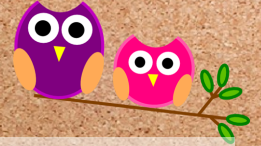
It has been another good week in Year 4 and the children have now made a good start on the Year 4 curriculum.
