The Hoot

Maths: This week we will continue to look at place value within 10. We will continue comparing amounts and using language like greater than, fewer than and equal to. We will be ordering numbers and objects. We will also look at ordinal numbers.

Useful vocabulary: count, more, less, same, different., bigger than, smaller than, equal to, fewer than, greater than. first, second, third etc

How you can support at home:

Really explore the different ways of saying more than/greater than,

fewer than/less than as we have found this tricky this week.

English: This week we will be using The Gruffalo as inspiration to create our own imaginary characters and we will be doing some writing around this.

How you can support at home:

Make some characters with your children or look for interesting characters in stories that you read. Describe the characters using adjectives. Eg. purple prickles, sharp claws.

Phonics:

We will are now looking at Phase 4. No new sounds are taught but we learn about reading and spelling words with common consonant clusters. E.g st in nest, nd in hand, nk in bank

How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work.
