Year 1 Victorian Toy Workshop

Our topic next half term is 'Which toys are better- Modern or Victorian?', so to consolidate our learning we will be welcoming a Victorian Toy Making Workshop into school! On **Tuesday 10th December** and **Wednesday 11th December** all Year 1 pupils will come together to look at a range of toys throughout history and explore the forces used to operate them and the materials they are made from. Each pupil will then assemble their own toy under one-to-one supervision.

There will be three workshops taking place over one and a half days to accommodate all three Year 1 classes (two sessions on Tuesday 10th December, 1HC during the AM slot and 1SR during the PM slot, and one session on Wednesday 11th December in the morning for 1DE).

A minimum contribution of **£9.20** to help cover the costs would be appreciated. If we do not receive sufficient funds, the visit may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online via Parent Pay. If you would prefer to pay with cash, please come to the office to collect a barcode, which you'll be able to take to your local PayPoint to pay with cash. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the cost being funded by school, however you will still need to give consent on Parent Pay.
