Science Super Learning Week—week commencing 14th October

SWALD ROAI PRIMARY SCHOOL Maths: This week we will looking at the number line, the addition symbol, and introducing the part whole model.

Useful vocabulary: add, plus, more, equals, part, whole

How you can support at home:

Practically look at how two amounts of something can be put together to make a whole. Use everyday objects around the house, pegs, little toy figures or even food like grapes!

English: This week we will be learning what a recount is and writing a recount our walk around Chorlton.

How you can support at home:

Ask your child to verbally recount their day at school or at the weekend. Encourage them to use the words first, then, next, after and finally.

Phonics:

We are now looking at Phase 4. No new sounds are taught but we learn about reading and spelling words with common consonant clusters. E.g. st in nest, nd in hand, nk in bank

How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work.
