9.30 am - 10.15 am

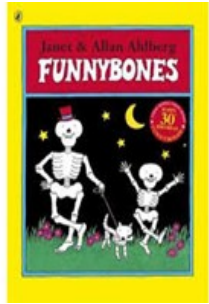
