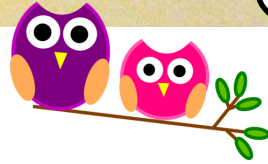

Announcements and Reminders

Upcoming Events

Global Day is coming on Friday 8th November.

Maths: This week we will be comparing number bonds within 10 and working on addition.

Useful vocabulary: add, plus, more, equals, part, whole, number bonds, how many more to make...?

How you can support at home:

Practically look at how many ways you can make 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10.

Use everyday objects to explore different number bonds, e.g., 4 grapes and 6 raisins make 10.

Which is bigger- 3 plus 2 or 5 plus 5?

English: This week we will continue to explore the story Beegu. We will be exploring his character in more detail by hot seating and writing our own version of the story.

How you can support at home:

Ask your child to verbally retell the story of Beegu. Ask them what Beegu is like.

Phonics:

We will be now looking at Phase 4. No new sounds are taught but we learn about reading and spelling words with common consonant clusters that come at the beginning of words. E.g. fr in frog, cr in crab, gr in green.

How you can support at home:

Recapping sounds that have already been learnt will help the children as it is helping them to remember to embed and use these in their work.
