Year 6 Trip to the People's History Museum

As part of our topic 'What Can We Learn From The Suffragette Struggle?', we will be visiting the People's History Museum on **Monday 25th November**. We will attend a 'Living History' workshop about the life story of a suffragette named Hannah Mitchell. This workshop uses performance, interactive drama activities and gallery exploration to bring learning to life. We will leave school at 9:15am and will return at 3:30pm. We will travel to and from the museum by tram.

If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. You can give permission and pay online for the trip via Parent Pay. If you would prefer to pay with cash, please come to the office to collect a barcode, which you'll be able to take to your local PayPoint to pay with cash. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you are entitled to the trip being funded by school, however you will still need to give consent via Parent Pay for your child to go on the trip.

Please ensure your child is wearing sensible shoes and a waterproof coat. School jumpers or polo shirts are to be worn for the visit. If a child arrives on a school trip without their school jumper they will either be given one from the spares box or a high-vis jacket so that they can be easily identified.
